5-ON-5 BASKETBALL LEAGUE RULES – March 2011
(with officials)

Kansas State High School Athletic Association (KSHSAA) rules will govern play except where noted below:

1. Each game will consist of:
 - a. Two 20-minute halves.
 - b. Two 1-minute time outs per half.
 - c. Five minutes between halves.
 - d. Remainder of hour to be used as warm-up for next game.
 - e. There will be a running clock. The clock will stop only on time outs.
 - f. The clock will stop on all dead ball situations during the last 2 minutes of the second half, unless there is a 20 point spread.
2. Game time is forfeit time.
3. Each player must present a community center issued player's card to the scorekeeper at the start of each game.
4. Each player must have a jersey with a number. A technical foul will be awarded for each player participating in the game without a number jersey.
5. Dunking is allowed in the 5-on-5 basketball game. No dunking in warm-ups. (Kansas High School Rules)
6. A team may start a game with 4 players. If a team has less than 5 players, game will be stopped if there is a 20 point difference.
7. The one-and-one free throw situation will exist after the 6th team foul in each half.
8. Substitutions must be made by reporting to the scorekeeper prior to the time of situation. The scorekeeper will then "buzz" you into the game at the next dead ball opportunity.
9. **Two technical fouls per player in a game will result in immediate ejection and a 2-game suspension. This is 25% of your league!!! Any ejection will also result in a 2-game suspension. Any fighting may result in suspension from the league.**
10. The clock will run during technical fouls.
11. Each team will consist of 5 players. Rosters must have 8 players minimum and 12 players maximum.
12. Two officials and one scorekeeper/timekeeper will be furnished for each game. The referees will abide by the O.P.L.S. rules and the current KSHSAA rules. All decisions are final.
13. Only one overtime period of 3 minutes will be played. If the score is still tied after the overtime period, there will be a sudden death overtime period. The first team to score after a tip-off wins.
14. Teams will receive one point in the league standings for each game won.
15. The officials have the authority to make decisions on any situations not specifically covered by these rules.
16. If your team forfeits a game, you will need to pay the \$10 forfeit fee by the following Friday. You may pay at MRCC or TRCC or by phoning (913) 895-6390. If the fee has not been paid by Friday, it will be processed on the credit card provided during registration.

To make a player addition, this form must be filled in, signed by the player to be added, and returned to the OP event supervisor or front desk at TRCC or MRCC and/or Recreation Services office. Players can be added to a team until the 4th week of league play.

After the 4th week of league play the team manager must obtain permission from Rex Groom, Recreational Sports Coordinator or Carl Cromer, Recreation Supervisor to remove a player from the team roster so a player can be added to the team roster. The team manager will need a written statement with player's name that is being removed and why the player needs to be replaced (injury or relocated out of the area). **Players that are removed from a team roster will not be able to play for the rest of the session.** NO roster changes the final week of competition. There is a 2 dollar charge for a player's card if the new player does not have a player's card.

Read then sign the PLAYER ADDITION / WAIVER / PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT FORM.
