7.10.010 Incorporation.

There is incorporated by reference, for the purpose of establishing minimum requirements for the operation and maintenance of such pools, spas and similar facilities to minimize hazards to health and safety of users of such facilities, comprehensive regulations entitled "Rules and Regulations Relating to the Operation and Maintenance of Swimming Pools, Spas and Similar Facilities in the City of Overland Park, Kansas," dated November, 1997 and approved by the Community Development Committee of the City Council on November 5, 1997; prepared, compiled, published and promulgated by the City of Overland Park, Kansas, Health and Environment Division, in code form as that term is defined in K.S.A. 12-3301 (c), such incorporation by reference being authorized by K.S.A. 12-3009 to and including 12-3012. Not less than three (3) copies of said ordinance shall be marked "official copy as adopted by Ordinance No. SPR-2081" to which shall be attached a copy of the ordinance codified herein, and filed with the City Clerk to be opened to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable business hours. The Municipal Court and all administrative departments of the City charged with the enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied at the cost of the City such number of official copies of such ordinance as may be deemed expedient. The Governing Body may set fees for inspection and licensing of regulated facilities by adoption of a Resolution. (History: Ord. SPR-2081 ' 1, 97; Ord. SPR-1980 ' 1, 96)
