The Overland Park and Olathe Police Departments hosted this year's Fourteenth Anniversary Chiefs' Summit.

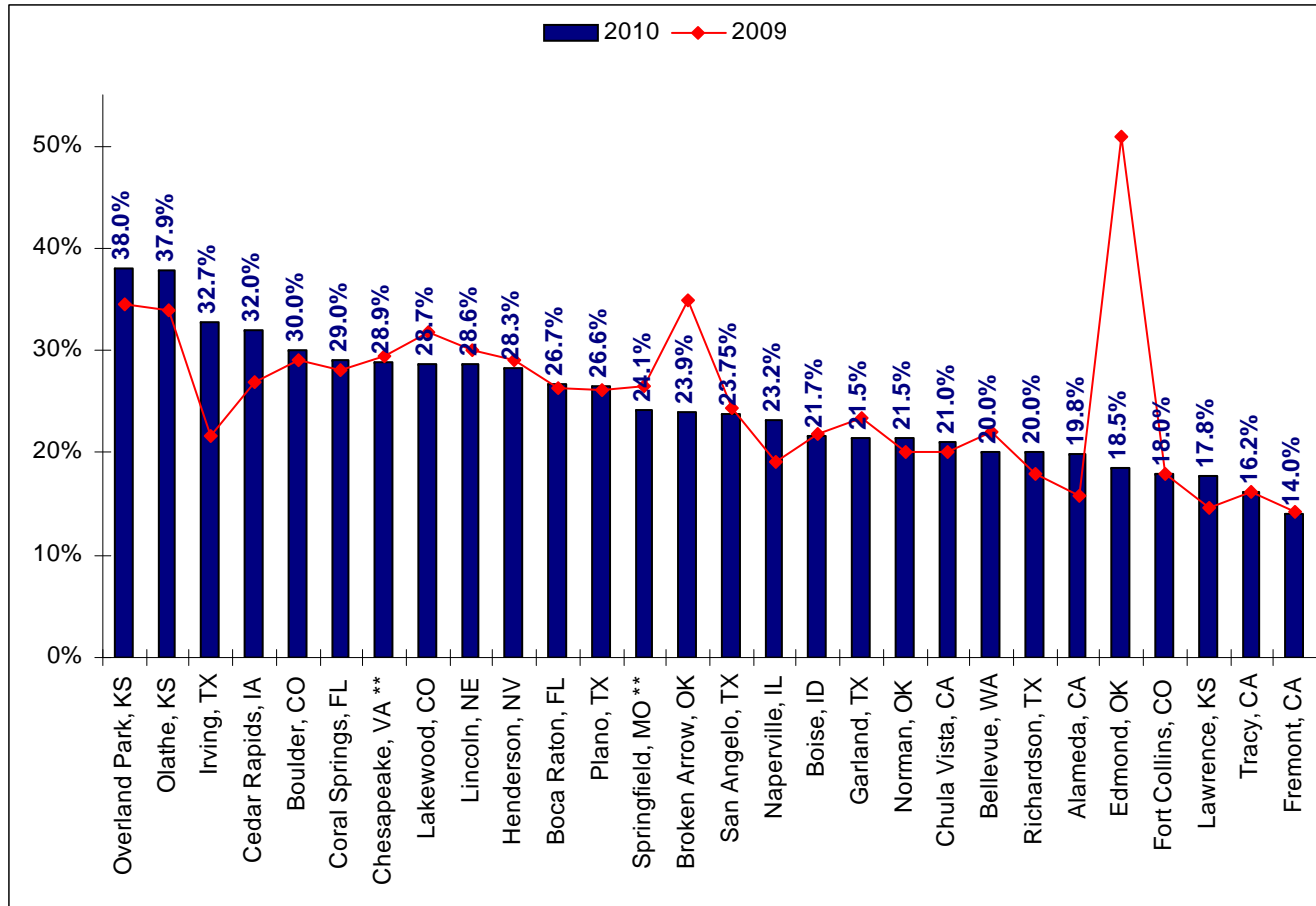

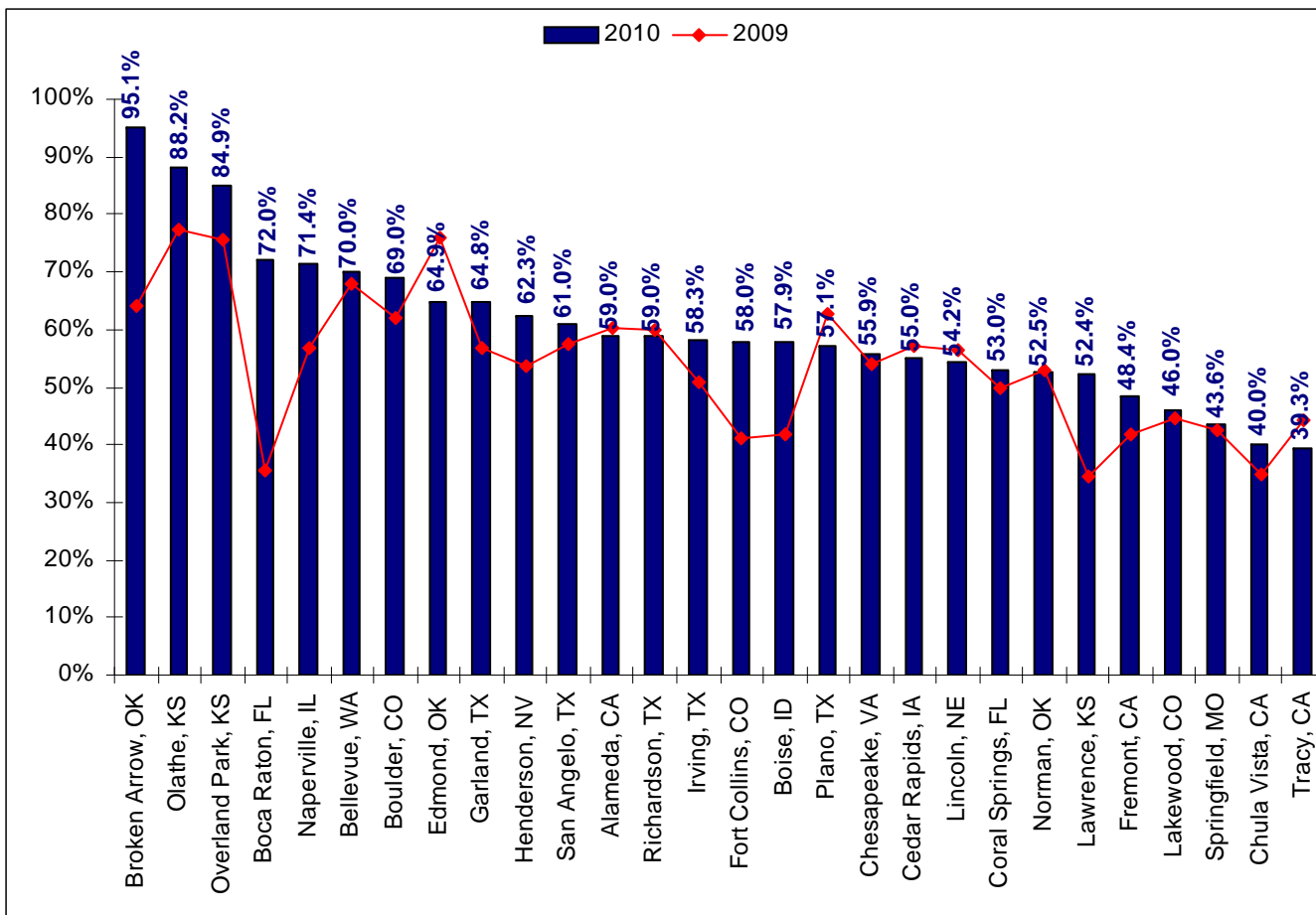

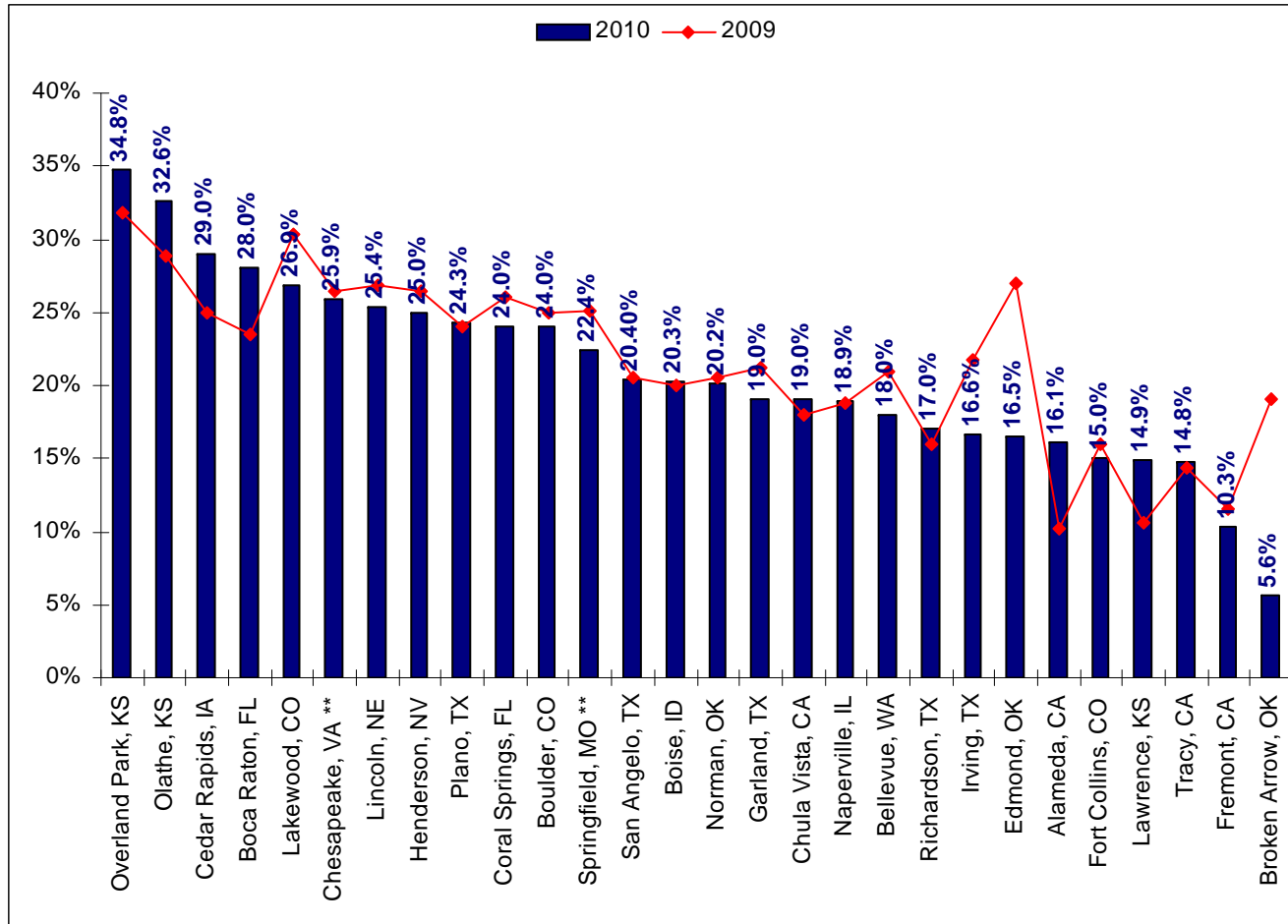

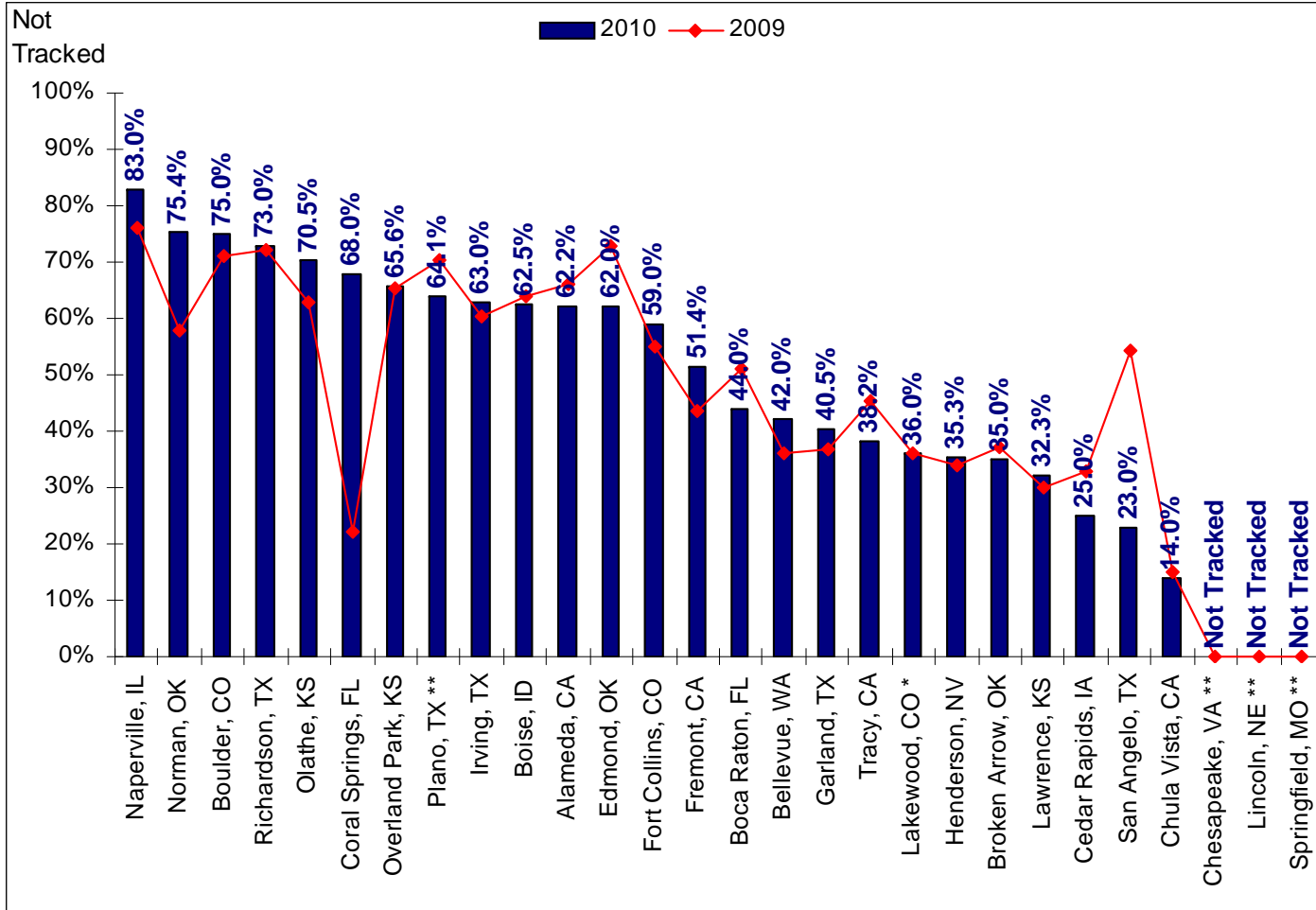

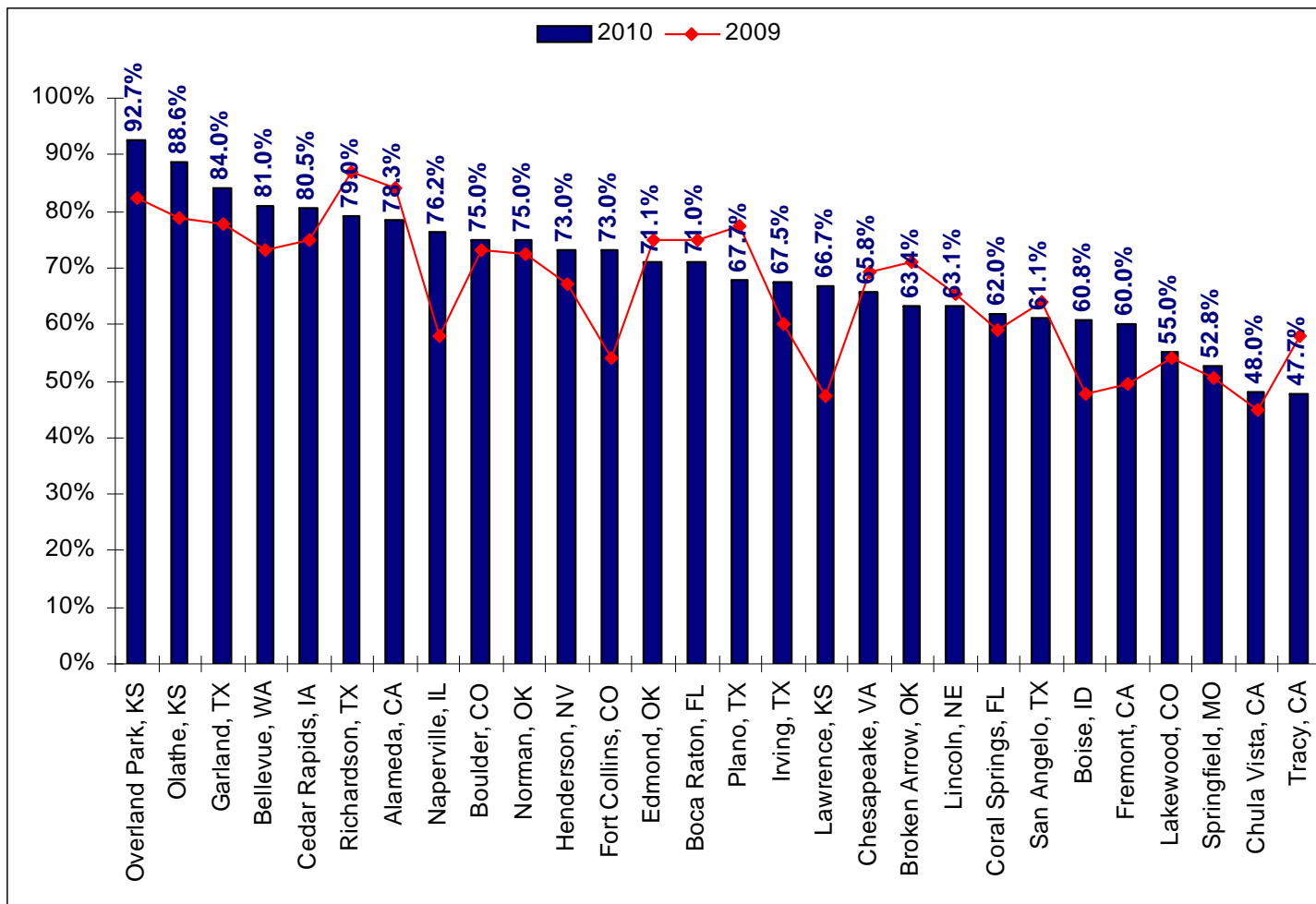

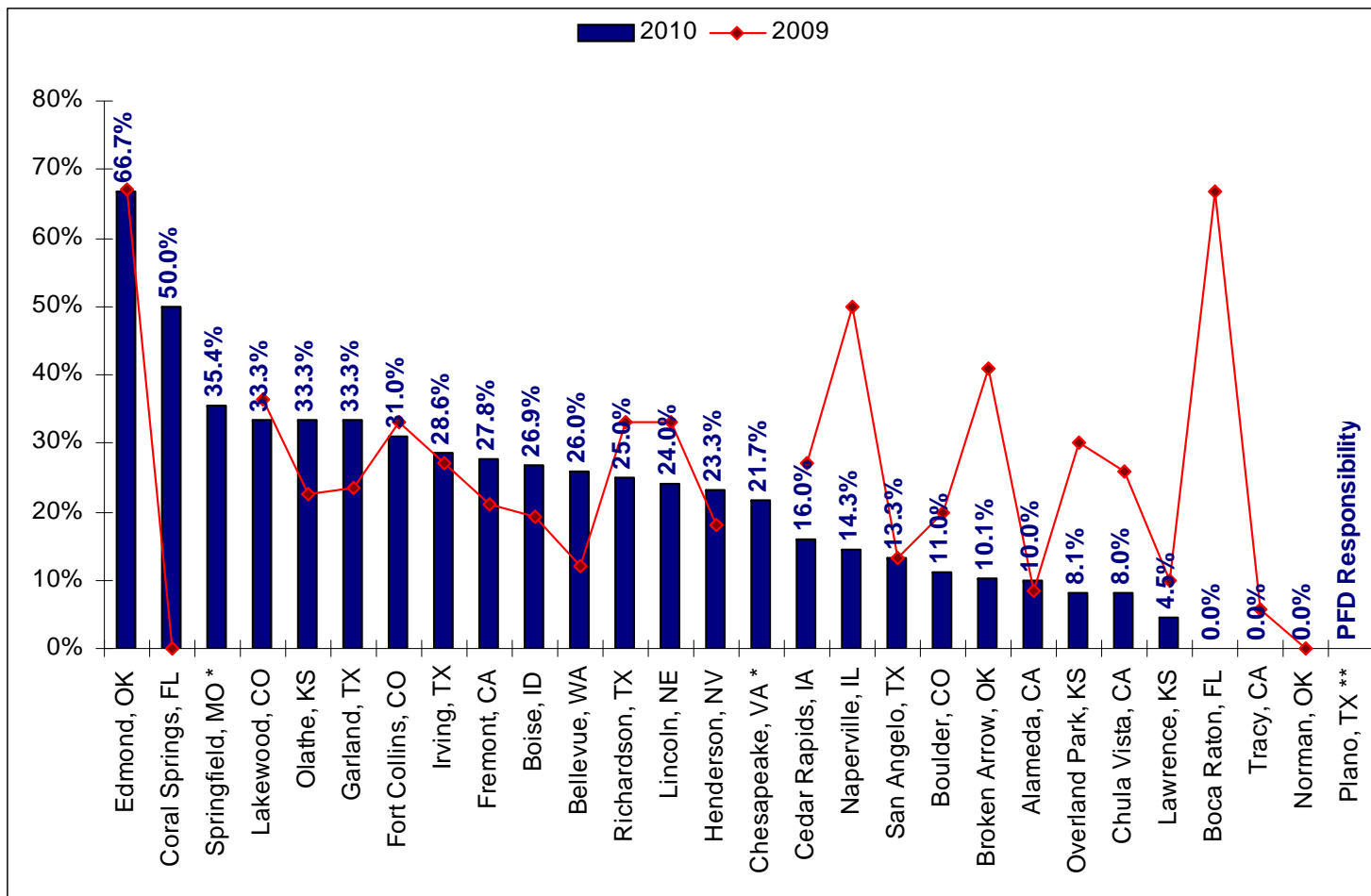

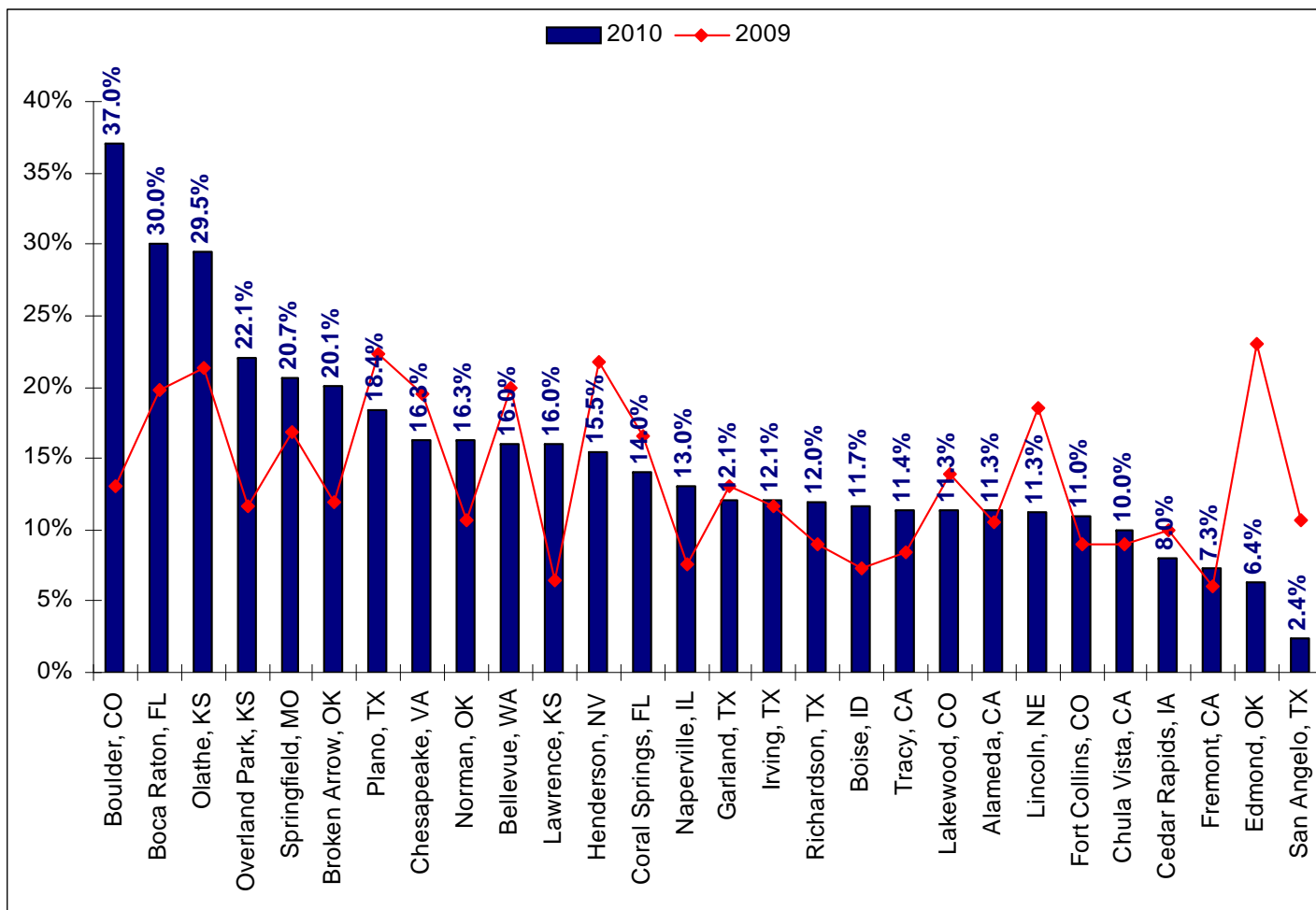

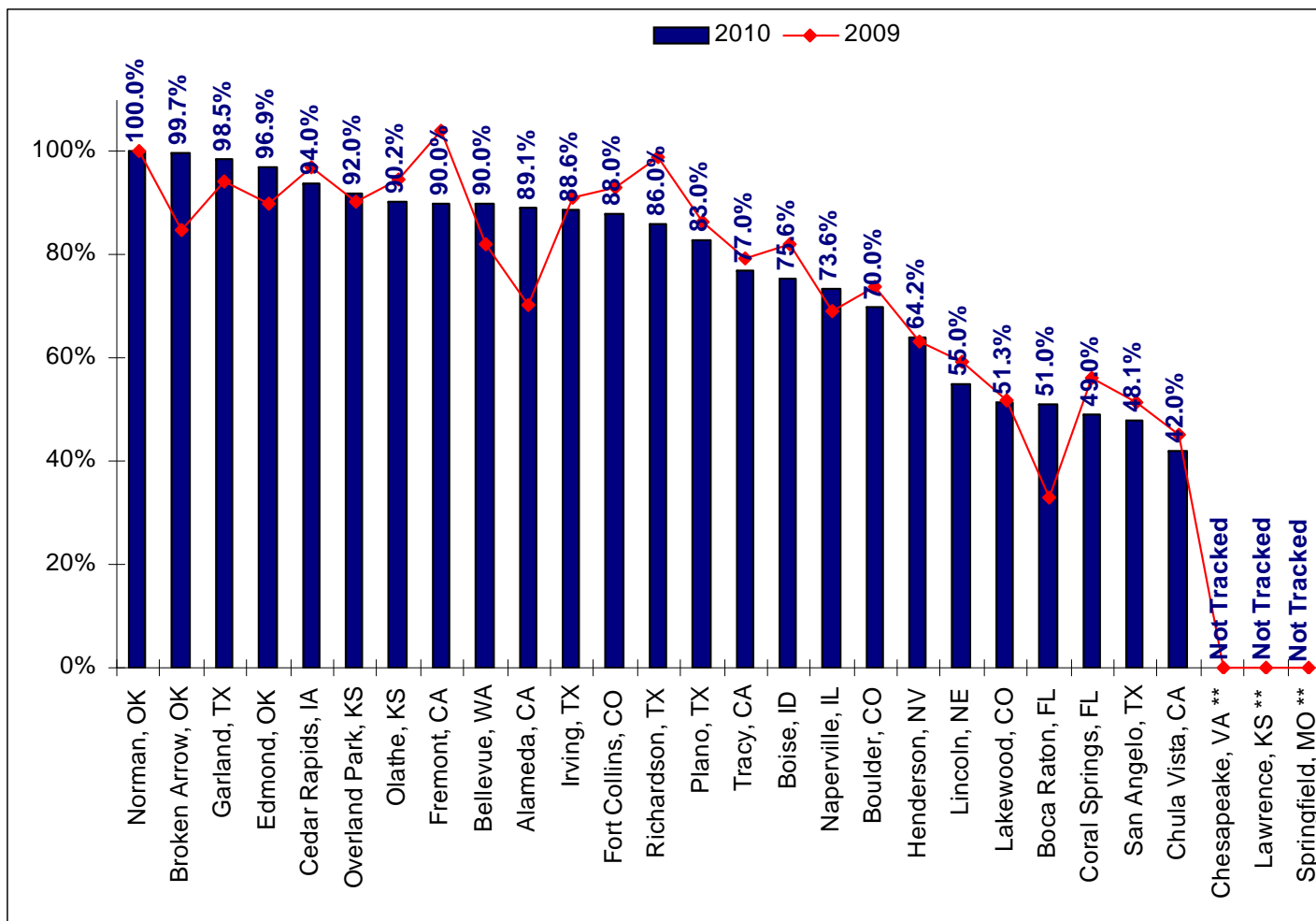
