

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. EIGHT

(Note: All or parts of this charter ordinance have been repealed. See notes at the end of the ordinance.)

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS, FROM SECTIONS 13-14a01 TO 13-14a14 INCLUSIVE OF THE KANSAS STATUTES ANNOTATED, RELATING TO EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEMS.

Be it Ordained by the City of Overland Park, Kansas:

SECTION 1. The City of Overland Park, Kansas, by the power invested in it by Article 12, Section 5, of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to make inapplicable to it and exempts itself from Sections 13-14a01 to 13-14a14 inclusive, Kansas Statutes Annotated, which apply to said city but not uniformly to all cities.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 3. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance is provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subdivision (c)(3) of the Constitution of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds (2/3's) of the members-elect voting in favor thereof, this 26th day of February, 1968.
