

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. FIFTY-SEVEN

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SUB-PARAGRAPH (e) OF SECTION 2, CHAPTER 114, 1992 SESSION LAWS OF KANSAS WHICH WILL BE CODIFIED AT SUB-PARAGRAPH (e) OF K.S.A. 1992 SUPP. 12-1696, AND WHICH IS THE DEFINITION OF CONVENTION AND TOURISM PROMOTION AND RELATES TO THE EXPENDITURES OF TRANSIENT GUEST TAX REVENUES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Overland Park, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to exempt itself from and make inapplicable to it the provisions of sub-paragraph (e) of Section 2, Chapter 114, 1992 Session Laws of Kansas which will be codified at sub-paragraph (e) of K.S.A. 1992 Supp. 12-1696 and which is the definition of "convention and tourism promotion" and relates to the expenditure of transient guest tax revenues. Such referenced sub-paragraph (e) of Section 2, Chapter 114, 1992 Session Laws of Kansas which will be codified at sub-paragraph (e) of K.S.A. 1992 Supp. 12-1696 is applicable to this City but not uniformly applicable to all cities.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in The Overland Park Sun, an official City newspaper.

SECTION 3. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect sixty-one days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, subdivision (c)(3) of the Constitution of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective as approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED by the governing body not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof the 6th day of July, 1992.
