

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. FORTY-ONE

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 12-1692, 12-1693, K.S.A. 1986 Supp. 12-1694, 12-1694b, and K.S.A. 12-1695, WHICH RELATE TO THE LEVY OF A TRANSIENT GUEST TAX BY CITIES LOCATED WITHIN COUNTIES HAVING A POPULATION OF MORE THAN THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND (300,000).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Overland Park, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to exempt itself from and make inapplicable to it the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1692, 12-1693, K.S.A. 1986 Supp. 12-1694, 12-1694b., and K.S.A. 12-1695 relating to the levy of a Transient Guest Tax by cities located within counties having a population of more than Three Hundred Thousand (300,000). Such referenced statutes are applicable to this city but not uniformly applicable to all cities.

SECTION 2. This charter ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the Overland Park Sun, an official City newspaper.

SECTION 3. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case, the ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED by the Governing Body of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 6th day of July, 1987.
