

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. SIXTY

(Note: All or parts of this charter ordinance have been repealed. See notes at the end of the ordinance.)

A CHARTER ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REPEALING SECTION 2 OF CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. FORTY-FOUR RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF "CITY OFFICER" AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, on January 13, 1993, the Public Safety Committee of the Council recommended passage of Charter Ordinance No. Sixty to the Governing Body; and

WHEREAS, on January 18, 1993, the Governing Body passed Charter Ordinance No. Sixty, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof; and

WHEREAS, on January 20 and January 27, 1993, Charter Ordinance No. Sixty was published in *The Overland Park Sun*, an official city newspaper; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to its second publication but prior to its effective date it was discovered that the introductory sentence to the quotation in Section 1 of the charter ordinance and the final sentence of the quote in Section 1 of the charter ordinance inadvertently had been omitted; and

WHEREAS, on February 15, 1993, the Governing Body, after proper notice of its intention to do so had been given, voted to rescind its passage of Charter Ordinance No. Sixty in the form that it took on January 18, 1993, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Charter Ordinance No. Forty-Four of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. "City officer" shall mean those individuals designated as a city officer by the City Manager. Said officers shall have the authority to investigate violations of City ordinances, order compliance and issue complaints and notices to appear.

SECTION 2. Existing Section 2 of Charter Ordinance No. Forty-Four is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in *The Overland Park Sun*, an official City newspaper.

SECTION 4. THIS IS A CHARTER ORDINANCE AND SHALL TAKE EFFECT 61 DAYS AFTER FINAL PUBLICATION UNLESS WITHIN 60 DAYS OF ITS FINAL PUBLICATION A PETITION SIGNED BY A NUMBER OF ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK EQUAL TO NOT LESS THAN TEN PERCENT OF THE NUMBER OF ELECTORS WHO VOTED AT THE LAST PRECEDING REGULAR CITY ELECTION SHALL BE FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK OF OVERLAND PARK DEMANDING AN

Charter Ordinance No. Sixty

ELECTION ON THE CHARTER ORDINANCE, IN WHICH CASE THE CHARTER ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ONLY IF AND WHEN APPROVED BY A MAJORITY OF THE ELECTORS VOTING THEREON.

PASSED by the Governing Body not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof the 15th day of February, 1993.
