

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. THIRTY-EIGHT

A CHARTER ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ELECTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS; REPEALING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 1-A OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Overland Park, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5, of the constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to and hereby does repeal Charter Ordinance No. 1-A.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the Overland Park Sun, an official City newspaper.

SECTION 3. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case, the ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED by the Governing Body of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 21st day of April, 1986.
