

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. THIRTY-FIVE

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF KSA 12-16,101, WHICH RELATE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CONVENTION AND TOURISM COMMITTEE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TRANSIENT GUEST TAX PROVISIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Overland Park, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to exempt itself from and make inapplicable to it the provisions of KSA 12-16,101 relating to the establishment of a Convention and Tourism Committee under its transient guest tax. Such referenced statute is applicable to this City but not uniformly applicable to all cities.

SECTION 2. The City elects to establish a Convention and Tourism Committee by adoption of a resolution setting forth substitute and additional provisions for such committee as shall serve the needs of the City.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the Overland Park Sun, an official City newspaper.

SECTION 4. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case, the ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED by the Governing Body of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 4th day of February, 1985.
