

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. THREE-A

A CHARTER ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF CITY OF OVERLAND PARK
CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. THREE.

Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Overland Park, Kansas:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of City of Overland Park Charter Ordinance No. Three is hereby and hereinafter amended to read as follows:

Section 3. The Governing Body may, by ordinance, provide that the Governing Body shall appoint the Municipal Court judges to hold office at the pleasure of the Governing Body.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper.

SECTION 3. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect sixty (60) days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, subdivision (c)(3) of the Constitution of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective as approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED BY THE GOVERNING BODY NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECT VOTING IN FAVOR THEREOF THIS 2ND DAY OF AUGUST, 1971.
