

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. THREE

(Note: All or parts of this charter ordinance have been repealed. See notes at the end of the ordinance.)

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS FROM SECTION 12-1036g OF THE 1961 SUPPLEMENT TO THE GENERAL STATUTES OF KANSAS, 1949, AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT.

Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Overland Park, Kansas:

SECTION 1. The City of Overland Park, Kansas, a Mayor-Council city of the first class, by the power invested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to and exempts itself from and makes inapplicable to it Section 12-1036g of the 1961 Supplement to the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949, said section being part of Chapter 101 of the laws of Kansas, 1961, but applies only to Mayor-Council-City Manager cities of the first class, and to provide substitute and additional provisions as hereafter provided.

*SECTION 2. The Governing Body and the City Manager shall be governed by the provisions of Section 12-1009 to 12-1014, both sections inclusive, of the General Statutes of 1949 and any amendments thereto, and Section 12-1015 of the General Statues Supplement of 1959 and any amendments thereto, in the organization and administration of the City, except as follows hereafter.

**SECTION 3. The Governing Body may, by ordinance, provide that the Governing Body shall appoint either or all of the following City officers: City Attorney, City Clerk and City Police Judge, to hold office at the pleasure of the Governing Body.

***SECTION 4. The Governing Body shall appoint by resolution auditors, accountants, engineers, attorneys, counselors and architects or any other person, firm or corporation who may be employed by the City for any special purpose.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official newspaper.

SECTION 6. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the Ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, subdivision (c)(3)of the Constitution of Kansas, in which case the Ordinance shall become effective as approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED BY THE GOVERNING BODY NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS ELECT VOTING IN FAVOR THEREOF THE 21ST DAY OF JANUARY, 1963.
