

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. TWENTY

(Note: All or parts of this charter ordinance have been repealed. See notes at the end of the ordinance.)

A CHARTER ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 AND SECTION 2 OF CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. NINE OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS, REPEALING SAID ORIGINAL SECTIONS AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT, THE SALARIES OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCILMEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Charter Ordinance No. Nine is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The fee of the Mayor shall be \$7,800.00 per year, payable monthly, and the fee of each City Councilman shall be \$4,800.00 per year, payable monthly.

SECTION 2. Section 2 of Charter Ordinance No. Nine is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The fees payable to the Mayor and City Councilmen shall commence on May 1, 1979.

SECTION 3. Section 1 and Section 2 of Charter Ordinance No. Nine are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper, The Johnson County Herald.

SECTION 5. This is a Charter Ordinance and shall take effect sixty-one (61) days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section S, subdivision (c)(3) of the Constitution of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective as approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED by the Governing Body not less than two-thirds of the members-elect voting in favor thereof the 1st day of November, 1976.
