

RESOLUTION NO. 2264

A RESOLUTION LEVYING A TRANSIENT GUEST TAX OF FOUR PERCENT (4%) UPON THE GROSS RECEIPTS FROM OR PAID BY TRANSIENT GUESTS FOR SLEEPING ACCOMMODATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS, FOR THE PROMOTION OF TOURISM AND CONVENTIONS AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A CONVENTION AND TOURISM COMMITTEE; RESCINDING RESOLUTION NOS. 2139 AND 2139A.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS:

~~SECTION 1. There is hereby levied, effective on the 15th day of August, 1989, a transient guest tax of four percent (4%) upon the gross receipts derived from or paid by transient guests for sleeping accommodations, exclusive of charges for incidental services and facilities, in any hotel, motel or tourist court located within the City of Overland Park, Kansas, as authorized by Charter Ordinance No. 46 and any amendments thereto.~~ [Repealed by Ordinance No. TGT-2092]

~~SECTION 2. The tax hereby levied shall be administered and collected by the Kansas Department of Revenue, and the revenue therefrom shall be distributed in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. Supp. 12-1696, et seq. All moneys received from such tax shall be credited to such fund or funds of the City as provided by Charter Ordinance No. 42 and Ordinance No. TGT-1589 and any amendments thereto.~~ [Repealed by Ordinance No. TGT-2092]

SECTION 3. There is hereby established a "Convention and Tourism Committee" to be appointed by the Governing Body of the City as authorized by Charter Ordinance No. 35 and any amendments thereto. Such Committee shall consist of eleven (11) members, who shall be hotel and motel owners or operators of such businesses located within the City of Overland Park, Kansas, and one (1) member from the Chamber of Commerce of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, seven (7) members from the Community at large within the City of Overland Park, Kansas, the President of the Council of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, and the Chairman of the Finance and Administration Committee of the Governing Body of the City of Overland Park, Kansas. Members of the Committee shall serve two-year terms. Provided, however, the initial term shall be one-year terms for one-half of the membership in order to provide for continuity on the Committee.

In addition, the Mayor of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, one (1) member of the City Manager's Office of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, and the Executive Vice President of the Chamber of Commerce of the City of Overland Park, Kansas, shall serve as ex-officio members of the Committee and will not have any right to vote.



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SECTION 4. Resolution No. 2139, adopted December 21, 1987, and amending Resolution No. 2139,A, adopted June 6, 1988, are rescinded.

SECTION 5. This resolution shall be published in the official City newspaper and shall take effect on September 1, 1989.
