We have developed an exclusive and limited opportunity for the friends and visitors of Deanna Rose Children's Farmstead to purchase unique personalized bricks, available for \$50 each, that will lead from the Kansas Farm Trail to the front door of the country schoolhouse.

The limited number of available bricks will be 8" x 8", twice the normal size, and may only be purchased for those who were either a student or teacher at a one-room schoolhouse. The special bricks will have the person's name, student or teacher, the year attended along with the city and state.

This unique path will help bring alive the history of our one-room schoolhouse to our young visitors and set the stage for the schoolhouse experience that we will present in our 1901 schoolhouse.

Farmstead Expansion

In March 1998, the Council for the City of Overland Park, Kansas approved a master plan that will more than triple the size of the Deanna Rose Children's Farmstead. The Farmstead has been a major attraction for the community with attendance of 350,000 visitors annually.

The park promotes family values and has served as an opportunity for children, parents and grandparents to spend quality recreation time together while learning about farm life and the animals that are found there.

The new expansion will consist of an authentic farmstead with all of its related buildings that would have been found in the early 1900's in eastern Kansas. Education and interactive activities will be emphasized at the new area.
