

RESOLUTION NO. 3782

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FEES FOR USE OF THE DEANNA ROSE CHILDREN'S FARMSTEAD AND AUTHORIZING RULES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE OPERATION OF SAME; RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2809.

WHEREAS, the City of Overland Park, Kansas, owns and operates the Deanna Rose Children's Farmstead for public recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Overland Park, Kansas, establishes and administers rules, regulations, and fees for use of said farmstead.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS, that the following policies and fees be established:

- A. The City Manager, through the Director of Parks and Recreation, shall have the authority to establish rules, regulations and procedures for use of the Deanna Rose Children's Farmstead.
- B. The Farmstead Supervisor shall administer said rules, regulations and procedures as dictated by the Governing Body, the Director of Parks and Recreation and the Manager of Golf Course Operations.
- C. Fees for use of said Farmstead shall be as follows:
 - Friday, Saturday and Sunday \$2.00 per person
(Friends of the Farmstead Members and Children under 2 years, Free)
 - Two free weekends from July 1 through August 31 of each year, with dates to be determined by the Director of Recreation Services.
 - Monday thru Thursday Everyone Free
 - Fees for birthday parties, guided tours, pavilion rental, activities, concessions and special events will be determined by the Director of Parks and Recreation through the Parks & Recreation Farmstead Directive.

Said fees shall be effective January 1, 2010. This Resolution shall be in effect so long as the Friends of the Farmstead shall offer a membership to residents of the City at not less than a 30% price discount.

ADOPTED by the Governing Body this 14th day of December, 2009.
