The City of Overland Park is seeking a qualified appraisal firm to provide the following combination of services: (a) appraisal, (b) waiver valuation and (c) acquisition services for the acquisitions of right of way, permanent easements and temporary construction easements associated with the upcoming Public Works street project:

2017 Neighborhood Street Reconstruction Program, a residential street reconstruction project of 5,250 feet of Grant Street between 79th Street and 87th Street.

At that time all sealed proposals will be transferred to the **City Council Chamber**, City Hall, where they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Any proposal received after the designated closing time will be returned unopened.

***Note:** The 2017 Neighborhood Street Reconstruction Program may receive federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding through the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). If CDBG funding is allocated for this project all services provided would need to conform to HUD rules and regulations, the federal Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, as amended (42 U.S.C. 4601 et. seq.), and other applicable federal laws, rules and regulations. Parties interested in providing these services may wish to contact HUD for the latest policies.

****Note:** Any contract resulting from this RFP will be paid from City funds and not from any CDBG funding that may be allocated to the 2017 Neighborhood Street Reconstruction Program.
