

Filing by Petition and Petition Forms

- Petition Forms should be provided to any candidate who wishes to file by petition, in lieu of a filing fee.
- The Petition Forms - Nomination Petition Form (PDF) and Affidavit (PDF) of Qualified Elector or Candidate Form are in a PDF format. This is a two page form. Both pages must be completed in order to be valid and page 2 must be notarized. Forms may be reproduced as needed.
- After the petition is complete with signatures, it must be filed at City Hall.
- Filing deadline for petitions is ten weeks prior to the general election at 12:00 noon.
- 1st Class City candidates who file by petition are required to pay \$35 Report Fee.

Petition Information

- Petition should be turned in several days prior to the filing deadline to allow for signature verification.
- If the petition is turned in close to the deadline and is not valid; it might be too late for the candidate to pay a filing fee.
- Candidate should collect more signatures than required in the event some of the signatures are not valid.
- If more than one form is being circulated for the same candidate, all forms must be submitted at the same time to City Hall.
- Every petition carrier must be a qualified elector residing in the appropriate election district.
- The Petition Form is a two page form. Both pages must be completed in order to be valid and page 2 must be notarized.
