

Permit Fees - Remodels, Tenant Finish, Additions, Decks, etc.

For residential or commercial projects, other than new buildings or small miscellaneous permits valued at less than \$19,001, the project valuation shall be provided by the contractor and is multiplied .005. The permit fee is rounded to the nearest dollar.

Fifty percent of the permit fee is required when submitting commercial plans for review. The other 50% is due when the plans are approved and the permit is ready to be issued.

The project valuation furnished by the contractor should include the total value of all the construction work except the value of the land for which the building permit is issued, i.e., land disturbance, site development, building cost, all finish work, landscaping, painting, paving, electrical, plumbing, heating, air conditioning, elevators, fire protection equipment, and profit.
